1. Welcome to our Partner Service

Newbury House Family Centre, Old Youghal Road, Mayfield, Cork T23 C3FW, is a Partner Service, working together with the Department of Children, Equality, Disability, Integration and Youth, and parents to deliver high quality, affordable, inclusive Early Learning and Care (ELC) and/or School Age Childcare (SAC) services for children. As part of that partnership, this statement outlines some of the important things you can expect from us, a Partner Service.

1.1 About Us

Here are some of the basic things to know about us:

A typical week for us is 9am to 5pm Monday to Friday for 44 weeks per year.

2. Early Childhood Care and Education Programme (ECCE), Access and Inclusion Model (AIM) and National Childcare Scheme (NCS).

Early Childhood Care and Education Programme (ECCE):

ECCE provides for 15 hours per week of preschool provision over 38 weeks per year before children start primary school at no charge to parents.

Access and Inclusion Model (AIM):

The goal of AIM is to create a more inclusive environment in pre-schools, so all children, regardless of ability, can benefit from quality early learning and care. The model achieves this by providing universal supports to pre-school settings, and targeted supports, which focus on the needs of the individual child, without requiring a diagnosis of disability.

This service also has an Inclusion Coordinator, Elaine Sheehan who has a special qualification focused on supporting the inclusion of all children in the service.

National Childcare Scheme (NCS)

NCS provides subsidies to parents to offset the costs of ELC and SAC. There are three types of NCS subsidies which are all available for children up to the age of 15.

3. Fees Policies

		As a Partner Service, we are committed to operating the 'fee freeze' for Programme Year 2022/2023. This means that we will not charge our parents more for the same service than what we were charging in September 2021.

		As a Partner Service, we are committed to operating the 'fee freeze' for Programme Year 2022/2023. This means that we will not increase our fees during this year.

3.2 Donations - We will not request or accept any donations, voluntary or otherwise from parents/guardians, in respect of the ELC/SAC services being provided.

3.3 Deposits - We will not charge any non-refundable deposits to parents/guardians in the respect of their ELC/SAC service where the parent/guardian takes up the service for which the deposit was paid.

3.4 In order that you can understand what this fee freeze means for you, we have outlined our fees and associated fees policy below.

This Fees Policy will be published widely.

a) The fee policy we are going to implement for year 2022/2023 is the same as the fee policy that we had in place on September 30th 2021.

Section C - Other Additional Information

A childcare place will be held for a child once the Registration form has been completed AND deposit paid. Deposits are non-refundable if your child does not take the place that has been booked for them.

- Fees must be paid in advance at the beginning of each week or month, online or paid to administration staff in Newbury House office.
- Childcare places require €30 deposit, refundable at the end of September/month after successful registration with funders.
- 4 weeks' notice is required in writing to reduce days/ hours or on leaving the service.
- Days attending will be fixed. (Childcare Services are subject to strict adult to child ratios and bookings are taken on this basis. Changes can only be facilitated if it does not affect ratios as set out by Tusla under the Preschool Regulations.)
- A late collection fee of €5 per 5 minutes applies to cover staff costs.
- Bank Holidays :Usual fees to be paid
- Parents Holidays: Usual fees to be paid

Sick Days: Usual fees to be paid

Preschool will close for 1 week in November and 2 weeks at Christmas. No fees payable these weeks.

Chicks: It is parent's responsibility to ensure National Childcare

Subsidies Chicks are up to date,

New chicks are provided to service on time and

Approved on parent's portal when claims are inputted by the service

Maintain attendance requirements as per funding terms and conditions

Note:

Our service is required to submit weekly claims and attendance to attain funding

Fees charged vary depending on subsidies awarded by National Childcare Scheme

National Childcare Subsidies cannot be back claimed therefore any delays in giving Chicks subsidies to service will result in full fees being charged

Fees are due at beginning of each week.
